Today Maurice Clarett has filed suit against the National Football League, Inc. in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York. Mr. Clarett seeks, among other things, an order allowing him the option of entering the 2004 NFL Draft as a hardship case and holding that the three-year eligibility rule in the NFL violates federal antitrust laws. Mr. Clarett's purpose in bringing the suit is to give him the right to use his skills and abilities to earn a livelihood, a right enjoyed by young people in virtually every other profession.
